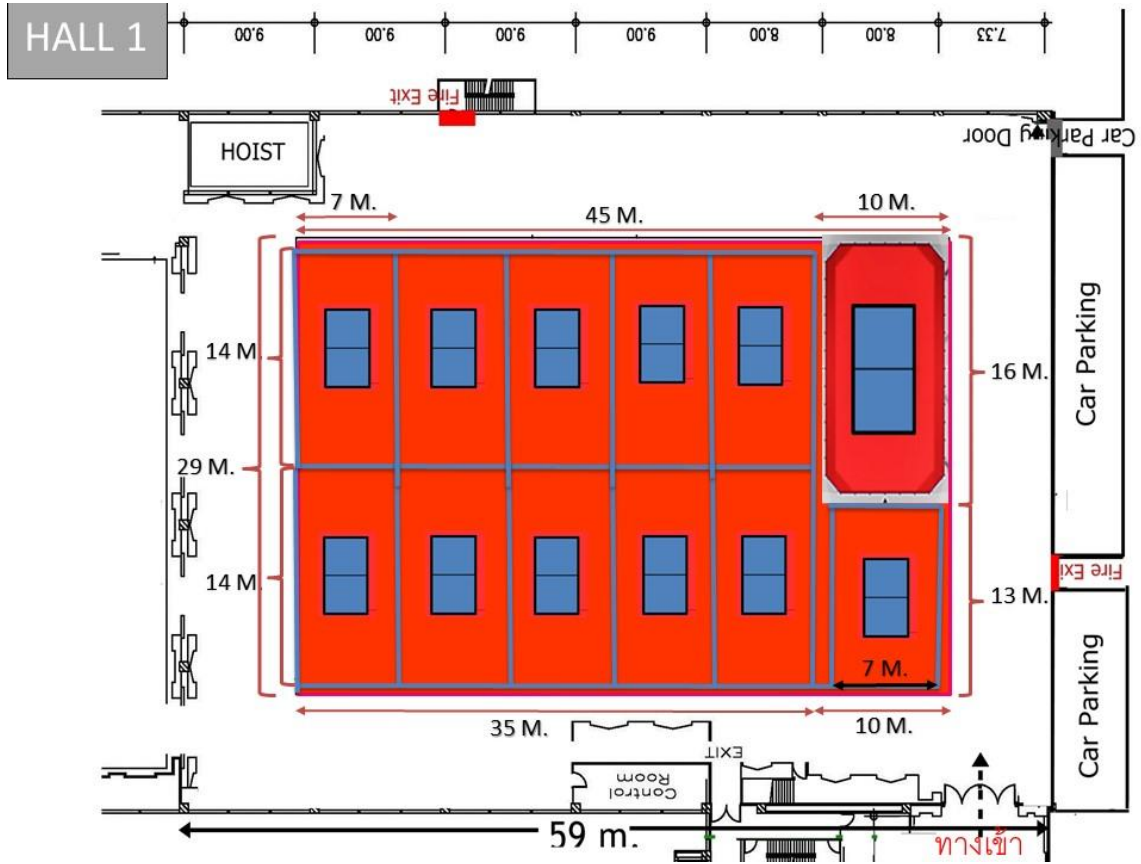

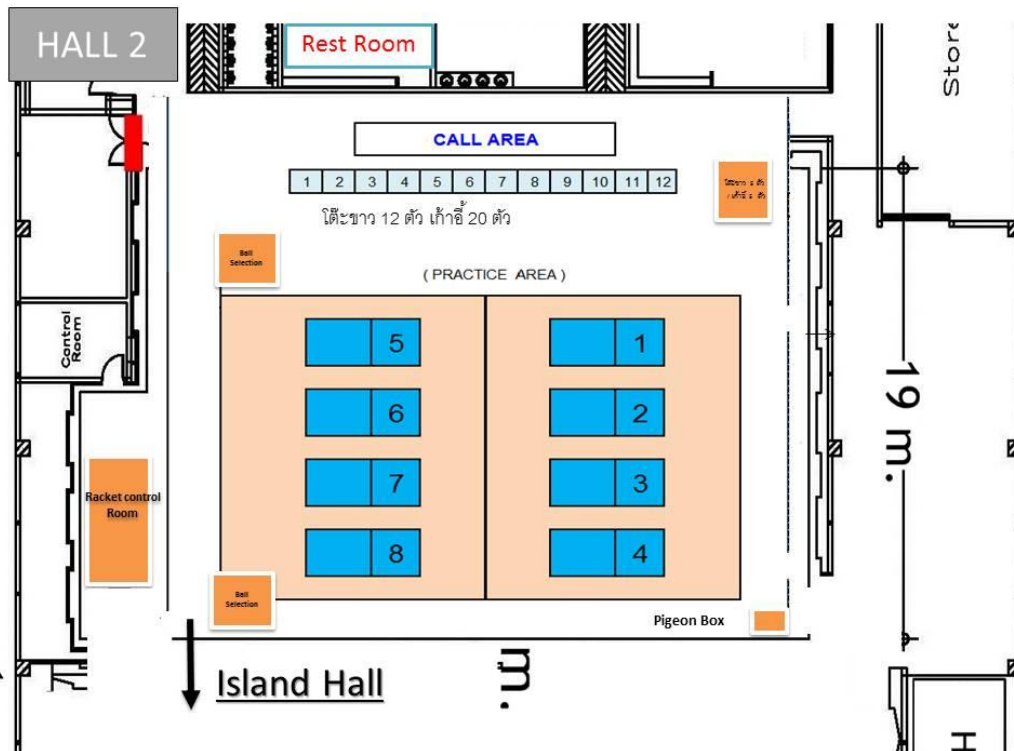
Junior Singles - Stage 1 – Best of 5 games

Call Area Procedures

- Reporting time: Team events-40 minutes /Individual events-25 minutes before match
- Racket checking
- Players should bring their playing shirts to show to the umpires, opposing teams/players should wear playing shirts of sufficiently different colour according to ITTF regulations.
 - Players are required to have their back number properly pinned at the back of their shirts
 - Ball selections – team events 2 balls each, individual events 2 balls each
- Players who failed to present at the call area 5 minutes after their required reporting time, will lose their rights to choose balls, shirts colours (in case of colour clash) and bench positions.

Racket Testing

- Players have to submit their rackets at the call area 25 minutes before their match.
- The rackets will be kept in the call area and the umpire of the match will hand the rackets to the players at the table.
- Rackets not being forwarded to the call area before the match
 - will be tested after match
 - The players will face the consequences of failures for after match tests

Coach/Adviser

- Singles Events - Only one coach nominated to the umpire before the match
- Doubles Events – If the doubles pair consists of players from different Associations, each may nominate an adviser – Treated as a single unit
- Team Events - 4 on the bench, ONLY 1 Coach + registered Players
 - Mixed Team - can have 2 Coaches + registered Players
- New rule on coaching:
Players may receive advice at any time except during rallies provided play is not thereby delayed;

Practice:

- There are 8 practice tables in the practice hall.
- Practice is not allowed on match tables when other matches are in progress.
